

Recovery Network of Programs Prison Rape Elimination Act Annual Report – 2025

The Federal Prison Rape Elimination Act was established to address sexual abuse and sexual harassment of incarcerated individuals in confinement settings which includes community confinement. Recovery Network of Programs maintains a zero-tolerance policy for sexual abuse and sexual harassment and provides guidelines for the prevention, detection, response, investigations, and tracking of allegations involving residents of any of its community confinement programs. Staff and residents are educated on Recovery Network of Program's zero tolerance policy and are informed on how to report an allegation. This includes third-party reporting.

The following are definitions of the outcomes of investigations:

Substantiated Allegation: An allegation that was investigated and determined to have occurred.

Unsubstantiated Allegation: An allegation that was investigated and insufficient evidence was obtained to determine if the allegation did or did not occur.

Unfounded Allegation: An allegation that was investigated and proven not to have occurred.

Ongoing Investigation: An investigation has been initiated and has not reached an outcome.
